



Report - Exit Survey for Restaurant Industry

The Restaurant Association of Nova Scotia (RANS) was interested to gather data to help gain insight as to why



some employees have left the restaurant industry. With significant labour shortages occurring in our sector, this information has helped us to determine what employees value in the workplace and to provide recommendations for potential recruitment and retention solutions. We began data gathering with a survey that was broadly distributed and followed up with one focus group and another questionnaire.




Unemployment Rate


Unemployment is now 5.3% in Nova Scotia - highest in the region! Look after your employees, it's going to get tougher in the labour market.

Latest Stats Can Trends

Month-over-Month (June 2022 vs May 2022 seasonally adjusted)

- Nova Scotia food services and drinking places receipts increased 1.4% to \$166.8 million
- Canada's food services and drinking places receipts increased 0.8% to \$7.1 billion.
- Five provinces reported monthly increases in receipts for food services and drinking places, with Ontario reporting the largest gain.
- Saskatchewan and Prince Edward Island reporting the largest declines in percentage terms.







Year-Over-Year (June 2022 vs June 2021 seasonally adjusted)

- Nova Scotia food services and drinking places receipts increased 26.4% from June 2021
- Canada's food services and drinking places receipts increased 30.5%.
- All provinces reported year-overyear increases in food services and drinking place receipts, with Ontario reporting the largest gain.
 Saskatchewan, and Newfoundland and Labrador reporting the smallest gain in percentage terms.


Year-to-Date (Jan -Jun 2022 vs 2021 seasonally adjusted)

- Nova Scotia food services and drinking places receipts increased 21.8%
- Canada's food services and drinking places receipts increased 38.3%
- All provinces reported year-to-date increases in food services and drinking place receipts, with Ontario reporting the largest gain and Prince Edward Island reporting the smallest gain in percentage terms.






Nova Scotia Sales by Establishment Type, Jan-Jun 2022 vs Jan- June 2021 (Unadjusted)



- Compared with Jan-Jun 2021, the gains in food service and drinking place receipts have been most pronounced for Nova Scotia's full-service restaurants
- In percentage terms, the increases were also notable for special food services (such as mobile and catering) and drinking places.



Trends

- Food services and drinking places have reported repeated downturns during imposition of COVID restrictions
- As these restrictions are eased, food service receipts rebound. Receipts for both Canada and Nova Scotia are above pre-pandemic February 2020 levels.
